COL Eric A. Martinez currently serves as the MilPay Transition Division (MTD) Chief. He is responsible for the planning, preparation and execution of the transition of Military Pay Roles and Responsibilities from the financial management community to human resources (HR) community. The MTD will prepare the HR community for assumption of the MilPay mission by serving as the Army's focal point and collaborative hub for all transition efforts.

COL Martinez received a regular Army commission from ROTC from University of Puerto Rico-Mayaguez earning honors as the Distinguished Military Graduate. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from Inter American University of Puerto Rico and a Master of Business Administration from Southern Nazarene University of Oklahoma.
