




Colonel Eluyn Ginés

Colonel Eluyn Ginés has served as the Military Pay Transition Division (MTD) Chief since July 2014. Colonel Ginés is responsible for the planning, preparation and execution of the transition of Military Pay Roles and Responsibilities from the financial management community to human resources (HR) community. MTD will prepare the HR community for assumption of the MilPay mission by serving as the Army's focal point and collaborative hub for all transition efforts.

Colonel Eluyn Ginés holds a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education from the Bayamon Central University, Master's Degree in Human Relations from the University of Oklahoma (Sooners) and Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy from National Defense University.

His military education includes the Chemical Officer Basic Course, Adjutant General Advanced Course, the Combined Arms and Service Staff School, The U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and Industrial College of Armed Forces.
